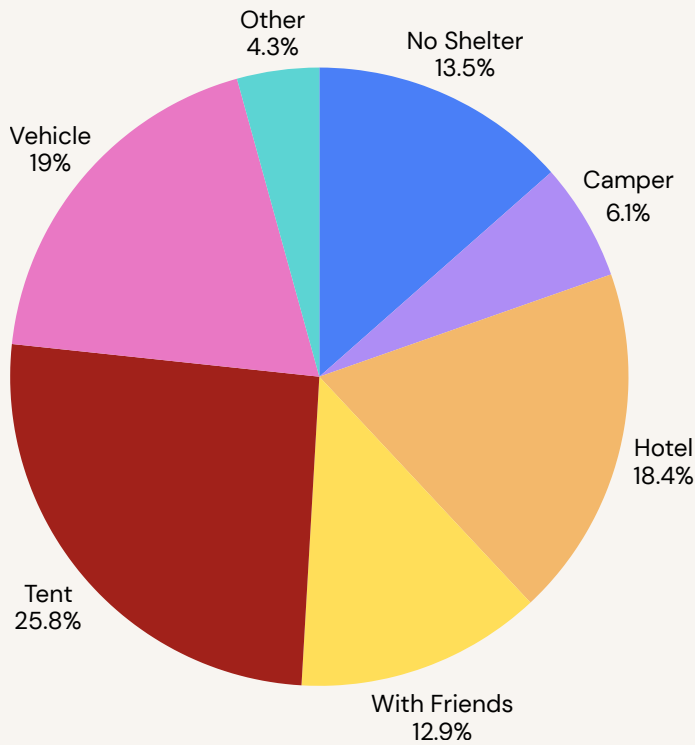
In 2025, Kinsman Redeemer made a significant impact, serving the homeless and displaced with compassion and dedication, providing essential items and support to our community.



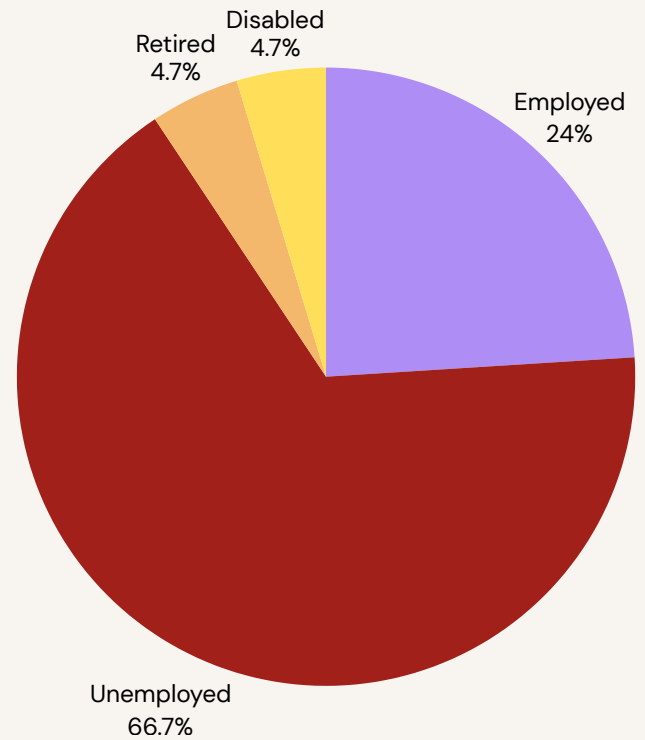
# Intake Form Overview

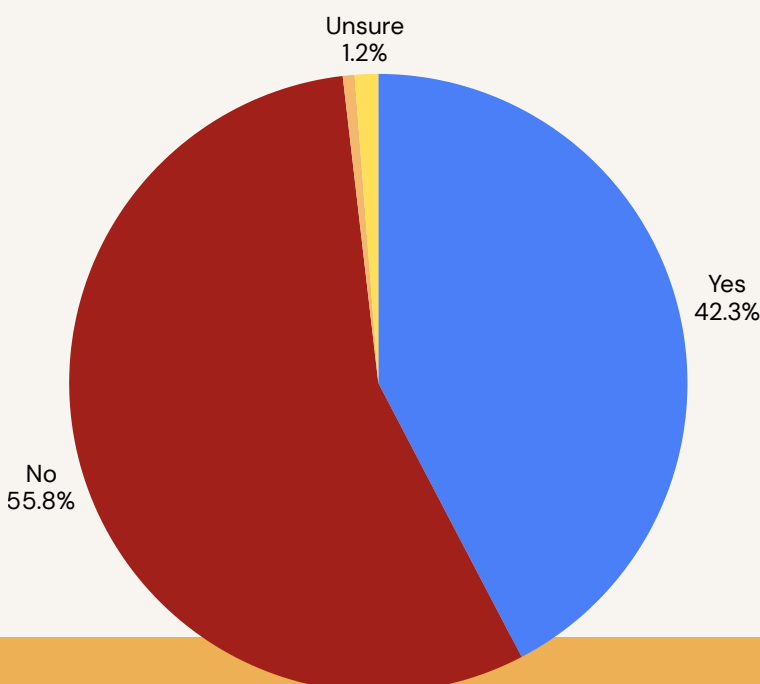
### Types of Shelter



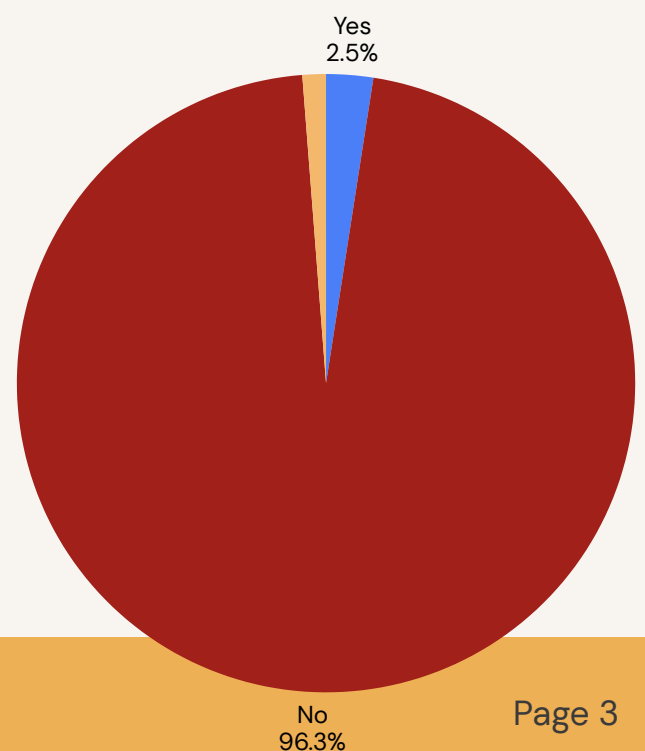

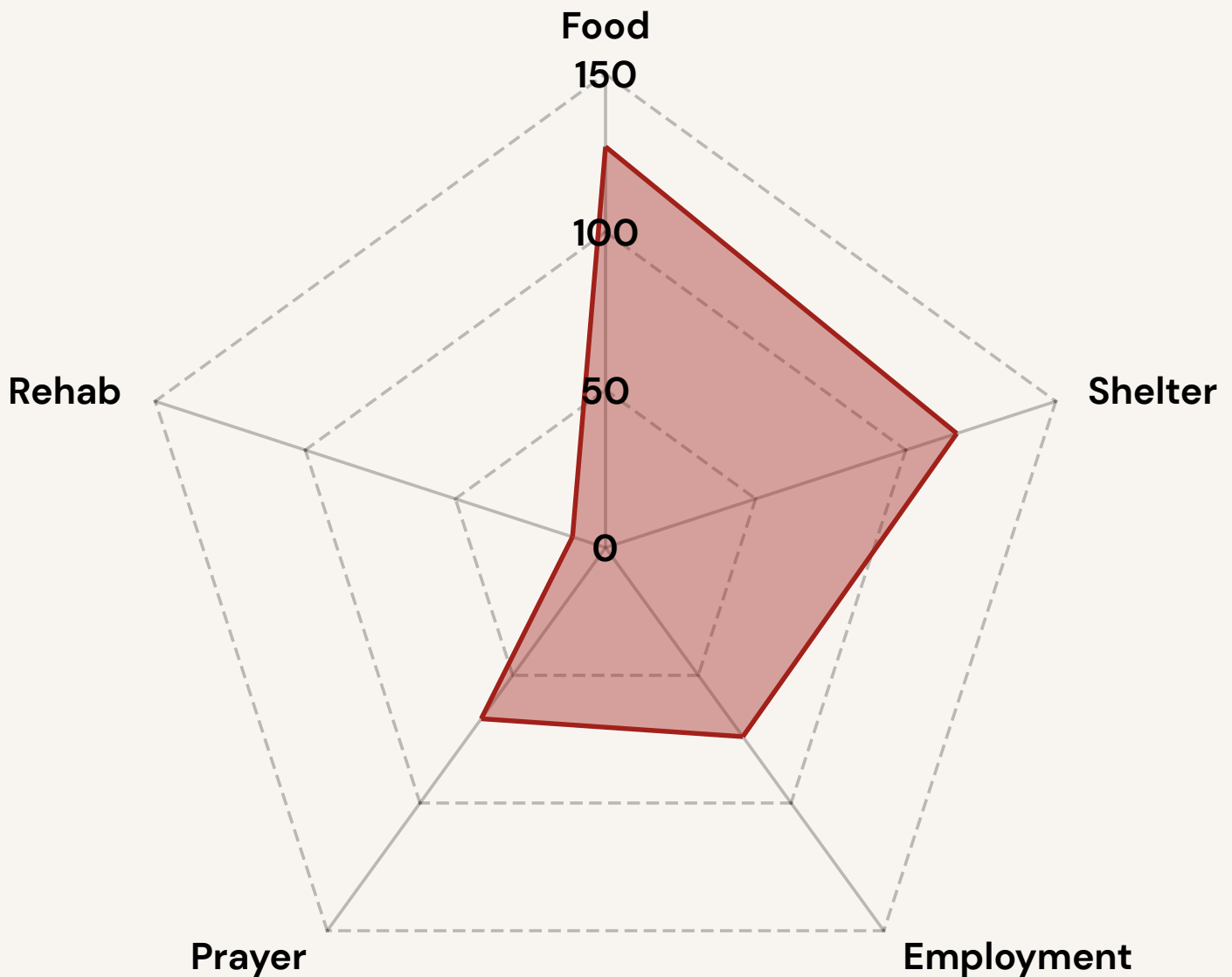

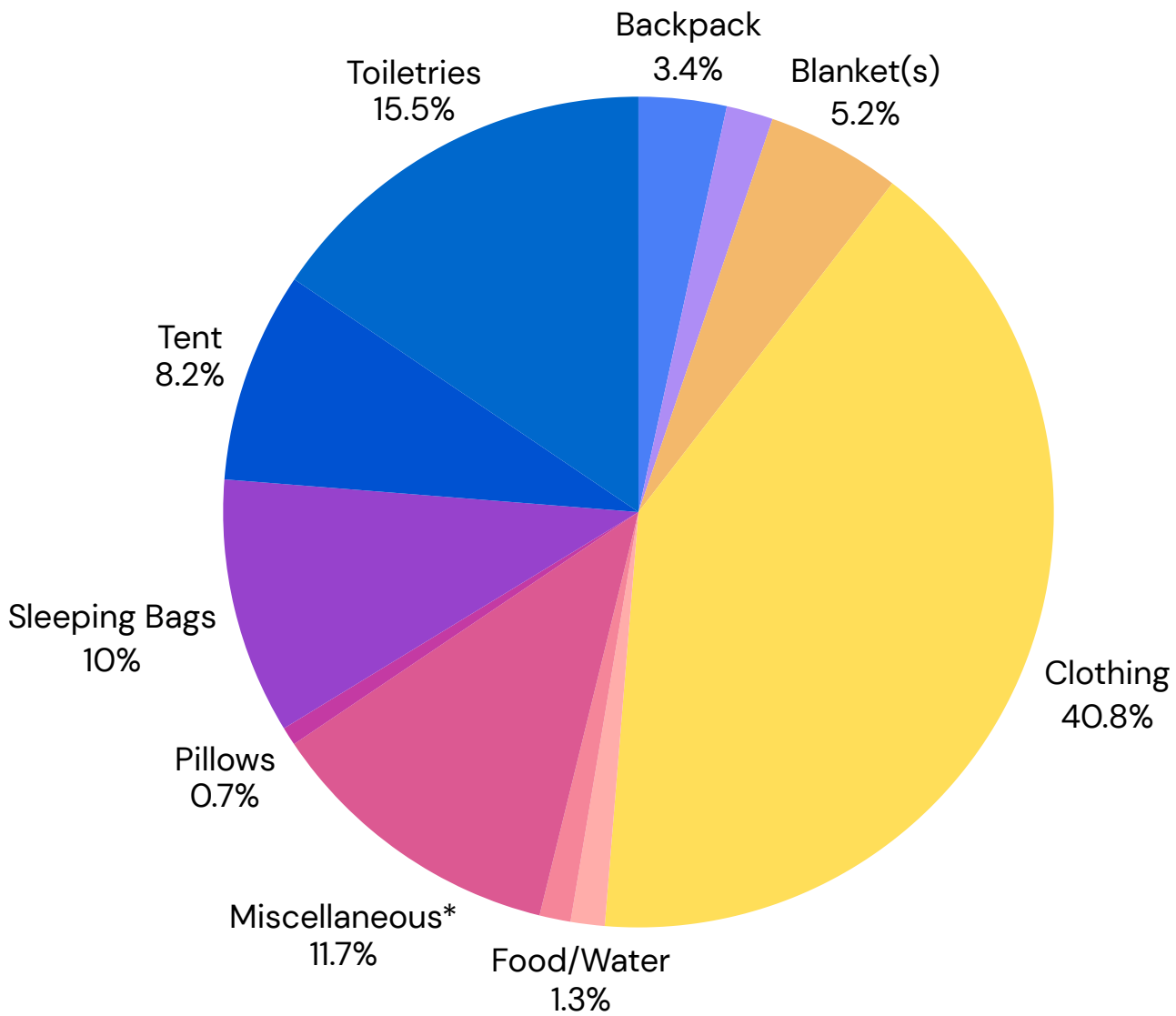

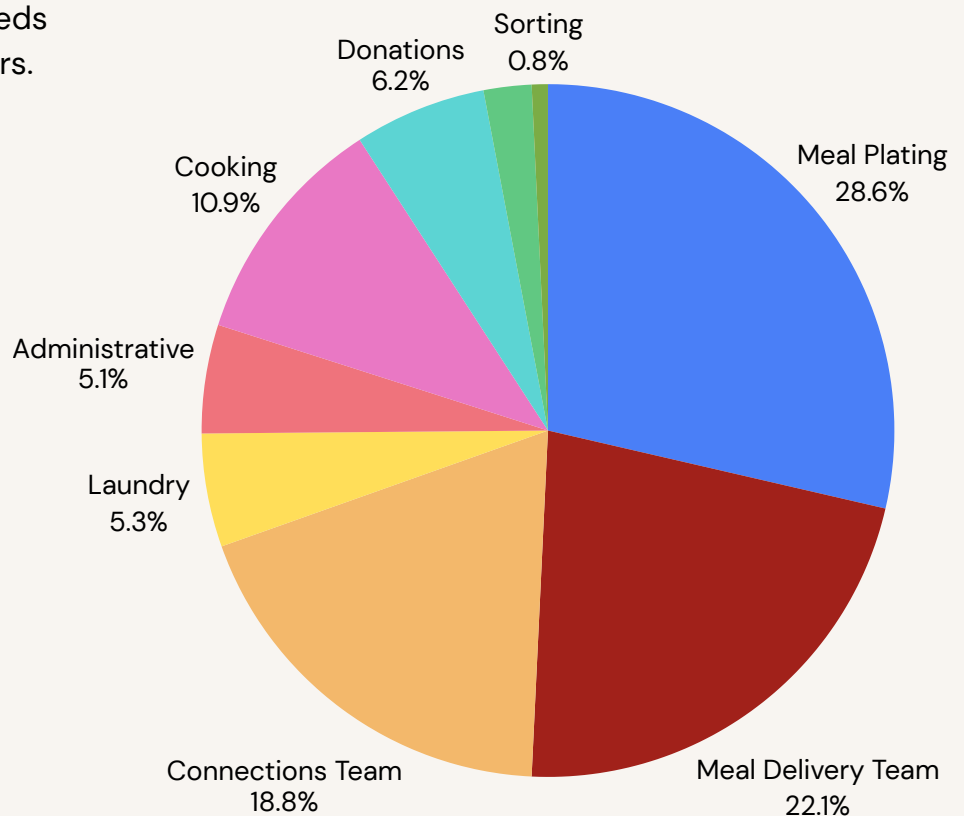
